Collaborative initiative to support and invest in our businesses.

What is the Community Business Investment Program (CBIP)?



CBIP is collaborative initiative between Kneehill County, Community Futures Wild Rose and it's businesses to provide access to capital and interest incentives to support entrepreneurs in enhancing their business.

Kneehill County will provide eligible businesses with an interest reimbursement on loans up to \$10,000 over a three year term.

Potential Business Improvement Projects

- Improve the exterior and interior of your business
- Purchase of equipment to increase growth or modernization
- Technology upgrades (point of sale, e-commerce solutions, website development, etc.)
- Designated office space improvements
- Creation of patios or retail bays;
- Painting, flooring, countertops;
- Removal of barriers for persons with disabilities;
- Replacement or addition or signs, windows and awnings;
- New architectural details or features;
- Removal or disposal of broken signage or fixtures; and
- Exterior lighting improvements.
- Business must be located within Kneehill County



How to apply?

Visit the website for eligible projects within your municipality. Develop a project plan and budget and approved by **Kneehill County**. Prepare and submit loan application.

Upon completion of the project and the loan is paid in full by the business, Kneehill County will reimburse the businesses the interest paid on the borrowed amount.
